



BATHING RULES IM FRANZERL

1. This bathing facility is not supervised

Supervision of children, minors, non-swimmers and people with disabilities is the responsibility of their supervisors. Guests are responsible at their own concerning risks associated with recreational activities.

2. Do not leave non-swimmers and children alone

Non-swimmers & children up to 10 years are only allowed to enter with a supervisor.

3. Do not jump into the water!

The water around the jetty is too shallow to pop in. Risk of injury!

4. Only for swimmers

Access to the water is made for swimmers only. The lake Weissensee is up to 99 meters deep.

5. Attention: Big passenger ships

Watch out for big passenger ships, which pass 50 to 100 meters from the shore. Especially when diving and snorkeling!

6. Behavior at the bathing facility

No running, jumping or pushing allowed. Do not climb on railings or rungs. Danger by falling into the shallow water! Danger of wood chips on the floor can only be excluded by wearing bathing shoes. Reeds can be sharp and pointed.

7. Storm, thunderstorm

In case of a storm or thunderstorm leave the bathing facility and close umbrellas!

8. Glas, shards, cullet

Do not take any glass with you to the bathing facility. Remove any bottles quickly. Immediately remove cullet in case of glass breakage and clean the place.

9. No access for persons...

- whose health status speaks against it.
- who are apparently under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.
- who are not guests of the house „Im Franzerl“
- when the maximum number of 20 people has been reached.

10. Times & scope of the facility

Bathing times are from 6 to 21 o'clock, but only in daylight. The facility is not made for use in the dark. The bathing facility, thus the area of responsibility of the operator, extends to the last step of the bathing ladder. For safety reasons, do not enter the area under the berth/jetty.

11. Changing clothes

As changing room you can use the bathroom in the bathhouse. Please leave the room in a clean and dry condition after each use.

12. Seat pads, umbrellas, etc.

Please put all pads for seats and sunbeds and other objects in the evening under the roof or in the bath house and close all parasols!

13. In case of emergency:
